Creekside's Mobile Food Pantry is catching fire

The Waxahachie Daily Light recently reported "Creekside Church in Midlothian is broadening its local ministry programs to include a once-a-month food service to area citizens needing assistance." The program is Mobile Pantry, a work started in May at Creekside. On June 16 the second Mobile Pantry Saturday more than doubled the number of neighbors who were served in May, and we're continually tweaking and expanding our process.

We had 44 volunteers, we served 39 households with more than 77 people! The sweetest families came through the doors: several we saw again at VBS!

One mom of four who came posted on Facebook the following:

"We came out this morning and everyone was so nice and helpful, my kids were a little overwhelmed at how sweet and friendly all the volunteers were. I think every one of them made an effort to speak to us. As a family of 6 on one small income, it's hard to keep food in the house (especially in between paychecks), this extra help is so very much appreciated. Thank you to everyone involved in this ministry!"

The next Mobile Pantry is July 21 and we're going to change things up a bit. We are going to continue deploying teams to deliver more food to neighborhoods and apartment complexes to help increase awareness and serve more families. We will set up "extra mobile" mobile pantries at different locations.

The ladies of Creekside are being invited to a women's conference in Midlothian that same day, so we're hoping we can get **AS MANY MEN AS POSSIBLE TO COVER THE JULY PANTRY** in order to free up the women to attend the conference.

We can't thank you enough for the number of volunteers coming out, the amount of love being shown and the servant atmosphere that is being created. We will get busier and busier with each month so please keep coming!!!
